- Northwest from US 60 - Take Superstition Highway (US 60) to Ironwood Road and make a right. Ironwood Road becomes Gantzel Road. Banner Ironwood Medical Center is located on the right side.
- Northeast from US 60 - Take Superstition Highway (US 60) to Ironwood Road and make a left. Ironwood Road becomes Gantzel Road. Banner Ironwood Medical Center is located on the right side.
- Northwest from Loop 202 – Take San Tan Freeway (Loop 202) to Higley Road. Make a right onto Higley Road and head south. Turn left onto Rittenhouse Road and head south. Turn left onto Combs Road and head east to Gantzel Road. Turn right onto Gantzel Road and Banner Ironwood Medical Center will be on your right.
- South (From Florence) – Florence Coolidge Highway to Hunt Highway heading west and eventually turns northwest. Take Hunt Highway northwest to Rittenhouse Road north and then turn right on Combs Road. Take Combs Road east to Gantzel Road. Make a right onto Gantzel Road and Banner Ironwood Medical Center will be on your right.

Health Care for a Growing Community

Banner Health is building in northern Pinal County to address the growing health care needs in the county and Southeast Valley. The 80-acre medical campus at Combs and Gantzel roads, adjacent to the Town of Queen Creek, will include a hospital and other associated services, such as,

- A full-service Emergency Department
- A focus on general and intensive care, obstetrics and surgery
- 36 beds including intensive care and medical/surgical care
- An obstetrics department with 12 beds along with four labor/delivery/recovery rooms and two c-section suites
- Four surgical suites
- Medical Imaging services (Radiology, MRI, CT and Ultrasound).

Room to Grow with the Community

Banner Ironwood is built to expand quickly with community growth. The first patient tower opened with 48 beds and can accommodate up to 86 beds when fully equipped. In total, more than 500 beds and supporting health services could be built on the 80-acre site.

Visitor Parking

Visitor parking is located in front of the main entrance on the south and north end of the hospital. Parking for patients and visitors of the Emergency Department is located on the far north end of the hospital.

Visiting Hours

Visitors can provide good medicine for patients. For your convenience, family members and friends are welcome to visit 24 hours a day. Please keep in mind that visitors may be asked to leave the room during tests or treatments when the physician or nurse needs to see the patient.
