Location Map

You can reach Cardon Children's Medical Center easily from most major roads. The medical center is located on the corner of Dobson Road and the U.S. Highway 60, just east of Loop 101.

If coming from U.S. Highway 60 (Superstition Highway)
Take the Dobson Road exit (Exit 177). Go north approximately 1/2 mile to the Dobson Road entrance.

If coming from Interstate 10
Take the U.S. Highway 60 (Superstition Highway) exit towards Mesa/Globe. Go approximately 5 miles east to the Dobson Road exit (Exit 177). Go north approximately 1/2 mile to the Dobson Road entrance.

If coming from Loop 101
Take the Loop 101 to Southern Avenue/Baseline Road exit. Go east on Southern Avenue approximately 1 mile and the Southern Avenue entrance to the medical center will be on your right.

Hospital Amenities

Banner Bistro Cafeteria – The Banner Bistro offers nutritious, affordable meal options for families and visitors to Cardon Children's Medical Center. The cafeteria, located on the first floor, can be found by following the butterflies on the floor from the lobby. Cafeteria hours are as follows:

- Breakfast 6:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.
- Lunch..... 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- Dinner..... 4:30 p.m. to 7 p.m.
- Late Night Service 11 p.m. to 2 a.m.

Train Garden – The Cardon Children's Train Garden is located on the first floor behind the main elevator bank. Children and adults can enjoy the train garden's mountain scenery and watch the trains during their visit.

Family Features – On every patient unit, there are a variety of family features to make the stay as comfortable as possible. Each floor includes kitchens for families and visitors to use. There are also laundry rooms and a quiet lounge for adults to use when they would like to get away from the patient room for short periods of time.

Safety & Security

The safety and security of our patients is a top priority; therefore, we maintain a secured unit. Our stairwells are not accessible to visitors to maintain hospital security. To access a unit, visitors must use the telephone located at the unit entrance. Family and friends play an important part in the recovery process, and they are welcome to visit whenever possible. Parents are encouraged to stay with their children during hospitalization. Depending on the patient's condition and and/or the family's request, visitors may be limited to one person at the bedside at a time to ensure the patient gets adequate rest. Young children may be restricted from visiting patients with weakened immune systems, areas with sensitive newborns and during flu season.
